Dear Angela,

I have now had an opportunity to consider the application lodged by my client. She advises that the premises are a food led operation and only provide Incidental background music. Mistakenly she believed that because Recorded Music and Entertainment of a Similar Description were already on the previous licence she should extend those hours. As the provision of incidental background music is exempt the Act I am instructed to amend the application to remove the request for an extension of hours in respect of Recorded Music and Entertainment of a Similar description. This means that the application is therefore limited to:

- 1. The Provision of Late Night Refreshment from 23.00 23.30 Sunday Wednesday and 23.00 00.30 Thursday Saturday
- 2. The hours for the sale of alcohol remain as they are
- 3. Extend the opening hours until 23.30 Sunday Wednesday and Thursday Saturday -00.30 to permit a drinking up time.
- 4. Extend hours for sale of alcohol on Christmas Eve by 1 hour on normal hours for the day Christmas Eve falls with an extra 30 minutes drinking up time
- 5. New Year's Eve Extend hours for sale of alcohol until 1.30 plus 30 minutes drinking up time ie to remain open to the public until 02.00

When preparing your report please could you advise of the above amendment to the application
