## **CONDITIONS SUBJECT TO WHICH THE ABOVE LICENCE IS GRANTED**

In the following conditions where reference is made to exotic dancing this shall mean entertainment provided by a dancer or dancers who dance in a provocative manner, removing some or all clothing in view of customers, and includes like entertainment taking place on stage, or in booths, and exotic dancing shall be construed accordingly.

1. Only activities which have previously been agreed by the Council shall take place.
2. Exotic dancing shall be restricted to the following designated areas indicated on the plan, being Striptease performance on stage male and female only in area E2. Individual nude dancing, female only, on area R3. Access to the dressing room shall be maintained at all times whilst exotic dance entertainment is taking place and immediately thereafter.

Exotic Dancers shall re-dress themselves before moving from the designated "Exotic Dance" areas to the dressing room.

Exotic Dancers are to re-dress at the conclusion of a performance and are to remain fully clothed whilst acting in the capacity of host or hostess.

3. No person under the age of 20 shall be permitted into the premises, or to remain on the premises at any time when adult entertainment is taking place. A clear notice shall be displayed in those terms in a prominent position at the entrance, so that persons entering can read it.

Anyone who appears to be under the age of 25 years shall be requested to provide identification. Only photographic identification shall be accepted such as passport, driving licence or citizen cards with holograms. If a customer is unable to provide identification then no sale shall be made, or when adult entertainment is taking place allowed to remain on the premises.

4. View into the area where adult entertainment is taking place shall be restricted so as not to be visible to passers by.
5. There will be no advertising of sex related entertainment either at the premises or in its immediate vicinity except with prior approval from the Council. The vicinity means no advertising within the Borough.
6. Exotic dancing shall be provided solely by authorised performers engaged by the premises for that purpose. No audience participation shall be permitted.
7. There shall be no physical contact between customers and the exotic dancers except for the placing of money/tokens in a garter or in the hands of the performer at the beginning or conclusion of the performance or for payment of drinks
8. At any time when exotic dancing performances are taking place there shall be no simulated sexual acts, or pseudo sexual acts.
9. The premises licence holder shall ensure that prior to any exotic performance all performers provide documents proving that they are over 18 years of age. Such documents are to be copied and retained on the performer employment file.

10. The licence holder shall maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system at the premises that ensures all public areas of the licensed premises are monitored, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, and which shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and video recordings shall be available to an authorized officer or police officer together with facilities for viewing. The recordings for the preceding two days shall be made available immediately on request. Recordings outside this period shall be made available on 24 hours notice (subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act 1998). Recordings will be maintained for a minimum period of 31 days with date

and time stamping. The Police and Licensing Authority to be given access to monitor live performances at all times.

11. There shall be a minimum of one SIA registered door supervisor present at anytime when the premises are open to the public for the performance of exotic dancing. In addition, a minimum of two SIA door supervisors shall be on duty every Friday and Saturday night, and any night where there is live music, dance or, disco event between the hours of 21.00 and the terminal hour stated on the current licence.

12. All incidents involving door staff shall be recorded in a suitable log, including all refused entries. The log shall be made available for inspection on request to the police and local authority officers.

13. The maximum numbers allowed on the premises shall be 50 when tables and chairs are set out or, 80 when the floor space is clear. On evenings where capacity is approached customers shall be counted in and out and a log kept to ensure the maximum capacity is not exceeded. The log shall be made available for inspection on request to the Police and local authority officers.

14. Toilets shall be checked every hour and a log kept of each check. The log shall be made available for inspection on request to the police and local authority officers.

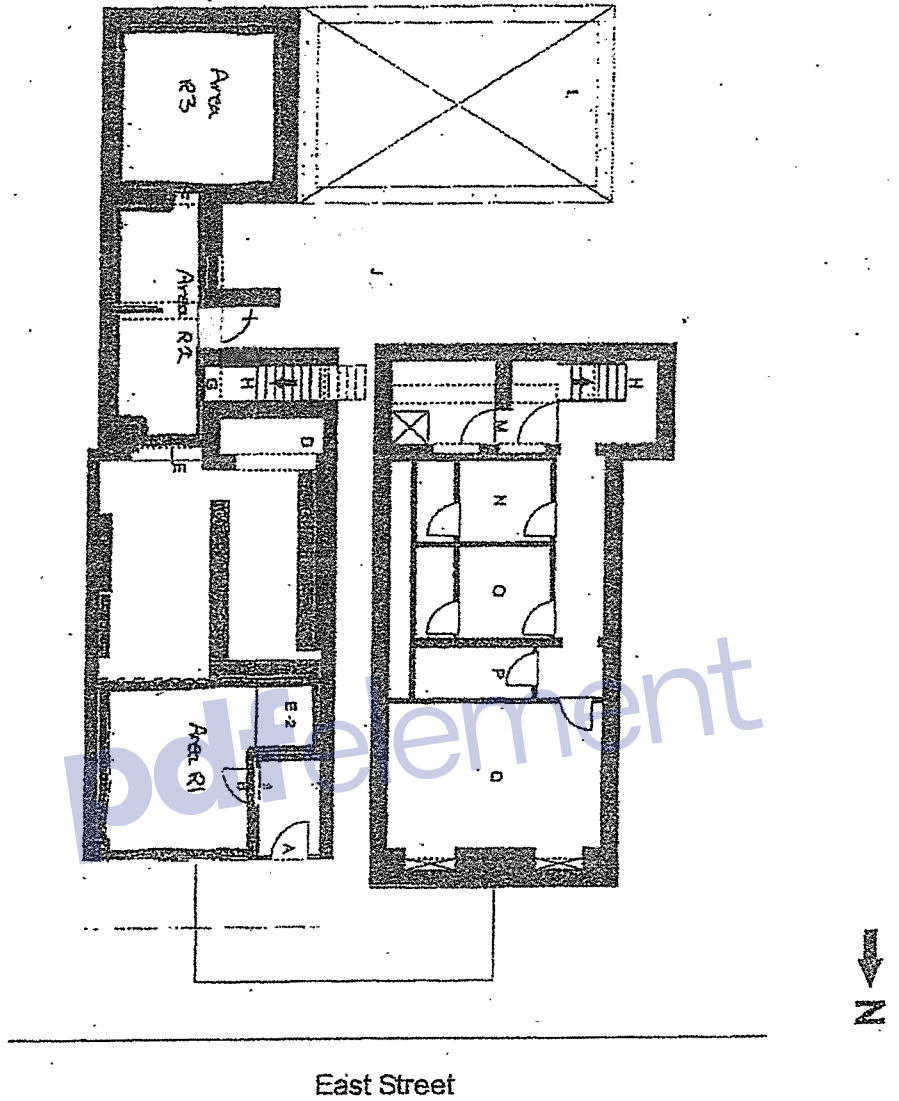
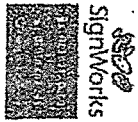
15. Exotic Dancer conduct - Dancers shall never give out personal information, including telephone numbers, or contact details away from the club; Dancers shall never accept any telephone number, address, or other contact information from any customer; Dancers shall never be in the company of a customer except in the ground floor area of the premises; At the end of the evening no dancer shall be permitted to leave the premises until all the customers have left the building and departed from the area, unless by previous arrangement with the management, or in a medical emergency.

The premises licence holder shall be responsible for providing all performers with a copy of the conditions attached to the licence before any exotic dancing takes place.

Notices outlining the House Rules for the premises shall be displayed prominently, at the entrance, and in the male and female toilets during every performance of dance. The House Rules will include details of the conditions relating to:- the over 20 policy; No physical contact allowed.

16. The window had to be obscured so that it would not be possible to see into the premises from the street at any time during a live show.

17. There shall be no adult entertainment on Christmas Day between 04.00 hours and midnight.
