REPORT SUMMARY

This report provides details of event requests for consideration by the Conservators.

RECOMMENDATION (S)

 - Epsom College (Thursday 23 Nov 2017)
 - Royal Pigeon Racing Association (Various dates from March to October 2018)
 - First Stride Events Ltd (Sundays 25 Mar, 12 Aug, 4 Nov 2018)
 - North Cheam Baptist Church Easter Sunday Service (Sunday 1 April 2018)
 - Rotary Club of Banstead Sponsored Walk (Sunday 6 May 2017)

- Round the Borough Bike (Sunday 13 May 2018)
- Cancer Research UK: Race For Life (Sunday 24 June 2018)
- Round the Borough Hike (Saturday 8 Sept 2018)
- Alzheimer's Society (Sunday 23 Sept 2018)

and decide whether they wish to grant approval for these events.

- (2) That the Conservators note the Calendar of Events for 2018/19.
- (3) The Conservators agree to the existing fees and charges remaining as they are for the 2018/19 financial year, and to carrying out a review of the fees and charges in October 2018.
- (4) That the Conservators note the fees and charges to be applied to each event subject to the event being approved.

1 Event Applications

- 1.1 There have been event applications received from eleven groups/organisations for forthcoming events on the Downs. Route maps for each of these events are included at **Annexe 1**, and an event calendar is included at **Annexe 2**.
- 1.2 All but two applications have been made by organisations which have run the same or similar events in previous years. The Orienteering Event and the Memory Walk have not previously taken place on Epsom & Walton Downs. The table below details the events.

- 1.1 The Pigeon Racing Liberation and the Easter Sunday Church Service have been rated as category U as they are expected to have very little disruption if any to the Downs or other users.
- 1.2 The Round the Borough Hike, Rotary Club Sponsored Walk and Downs Young Athletes Cross Country League events are expected to have very little if any impact on the Downs and other users of the Downs, and so have been rated as category A.
- 1.3 The Orienteering event, Surrey Cross Country League, Epsom College Cross Country event, 5K & 10K Summer Series and The Round the Borough Bike events are expected to attract a larger number of participants and so have been rated as category B. All events have previously taken place on the Downs although the Orienteering event was a scaled down version of the event applied for in October.
- 1.4 The Race for Life and Alzheimer's Society Memory Walk event have been rated as category D. The latter has not previously run on the Downs but the organisers are keen to work with the Downskeepers and the trainers to ensure minimal disruption and impact on the Downs.
- 1.5 The Downskeepers and trainers have not been consulted directly and so their comments are welcome as part of the Conservators consideration of the events. The important matter of staying on designated paths and not straying onto Training Grounds will be stressed to all organisers.
- 1.6 All organisations have sent through the necessary paperwork, which includes copies of their public liability insurance and risk assessments. Maps of each route for the events are attached at **Annexe 1**.

2 Calendar of events

2.1 The calendar of forthcoming events is attached at **Annexe 2**. The events shown in **bold** are for consideration by the Conservators at this meeting.

2.2 The Event Management Strategy sets out suggested limits on the number of events to be held on the Downs each year, and these are detailed in the tables below, alongside the number of events currently approved and those waiting to be approved:

3 Future Events

- 3.1 At the meeting on 18 January 2017, the Conservators reviewed and updated the charging policy for events on the Downs.
- 3.2 For the purposes of this report, those events subject to a hire charge and refundable reinstatement bond have been charged at the new rate as agreed on 18 January 2017. The Round the Borough Hike & Bike events will not be subject to any charge as agreed at the meeting of the Conservators on 7 October 2015.
- 3.3 Due to the increase in charges in January 2017, it is proposed that no further increases in the fees and charges for events on the Downs be made for 2018. A review of the fees and charges for 2019/20 will be carried out in October 2018.
