1 Derby Festival

- 1.1 The build-up to the Derby Festival ran smoothly with no significant issues to report.
- 1.2 The Head Downskeeper would like to pass on sincere thanks to the cleaning contractors for the speed and efficiency of the clean-up operation. No complaints were received and the Downs were returned to its former glory in record time.
- 1.3 Although the Gypsy site did not cause any major issues during the Festival, the Downskeepers collected more fly-tipping than usual. As the fly-tipped material mostly comprised of green waste, this has been compacted into one area so that it can be dealt with on-site by Council's Eco Green composter/shredder machine to save on removal costs.
