Development Management Performance Update

Statistics showing the Council's progress in meeting performance targets for 'Major' 'Minor' and 'Other' planning applications is shown below. The data is shown quarterly, as provided to the Department for Levelling Up, Housing & Communities, with the most recent Quarter (Q1 2022) in bold and previous Quarters shown for information:

Major planning applications (target 60%):

The data shows that there has been a significant increase in the number of decisions issued over the past Quarter – this is largely as a result of the work

done to clear the backlog of older 'out of time' planning applications. The backlog of Major, Minor and Other planning applications is currently at 125, a reduction of over 65% from the 383 out of time applications at the beginning of the year. The overall number of planning applications now determined 'in time' is increasing as the backlog of old applications decreases.
