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Car Park Permit Proposal 2023/24 – additional item

The Car Park Working Group have agreed a proposal to offer a new Resident Annual Permit in Upper High Street car park. The permit would be available to residents of Upper High Street and Stevens Close initially and applications will be capped if there is a concern that permit numbers will greatly impact on available spaces for visitors to Epsom’s retail establishments.

The introductory fee is proposed to be £420 keeping it in line with the Resident permit prices in the car parks at Hook Road, Chessington Road and Stoneleigh Parade.
