Method of calculation:

- A) Add actual points awarded excluding the N/A's
- B) Add the maximum achievable in each applicable section
- C) Divide: $A/B * 200 = \text{Grade}$

Example: Four items as N/A's, points scored say 87, maximum possible in applicable sections, 125
therefore $87/125 * 200 = 139.2 = \text{Silver Gilt}$
