Surrey Police support the representation submitted by Immigration to review the Licence. I would like to comment by bringing to attention Section 11.28 of the 182 Licensing Guidance:

“11.28 It is envisaged that licensing authorities, the police, the Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) and other law enforcement agencies, which are responsible authorities, will use the review procedures effectively to deter such activities and crime. **Where reviews arise and the licensing authority determines that the crime prevention objective is being undermined through the premises being used to further crimes, it is expected that revocation of the licence – even in the first instance – should be seriously considered.**”

As the main crime is around IE, Surrey Police have no representations other than a comment of support to revoke the licence.
