## Representations are being made for the following reasons:

An Enforcement visit was conducted on 01/09/2022. One person was encountered with no right to work in the United Kingdom. A civil penalty for £10,000 was issued the business.

Immigration Enforcement previously visited the premises on 26/05/2016, where they encountered four persons with no right to work in the United Kingdom.

The business at the time of the visit was owned by Bayleaves (Gorment) Limited of which Mr Alom Hussain was the Director. A civil penalty of £60,000 was issued to the business for the employment of four persons with no right to work in the United Kingdom. The company was Dissolved on 18/05/2019.
