iii. Cites the reason or reasons why the decision should be called in. Relevant reasons will be:

That, in making the decision, the committee or decision-making body has not had regard to certain relevant evidence – either because it was not brought to the attention of the committee at the time or because it was not available.

The LGA Cultural Peer Challenge report which was commissioned to explore a wide range of questions has not been published and was not shared with members. What scant information is available demonstrates that significant sections of the CPC scope and purpose are missing from the curated headline extracts in the committee papers.

These were specifically germane to the future governance and funding of the museum. At the meeting the committee chair is very clear that he "should" have shared the report with members, but this did not happen. Members were deprived of access to relevant evidence because it was not brought to the attention of the committee.
