Good Morning Paul,

Thank you for the revised Policy and giving Police the chance to read the amendments. I can confirm that the wording chosen fulfils the concerns Police had around the enforcement of SSA. By using “will require” gives a definitive objective the applicants must do. We felt “will expect” was too vague and gave the applicant the opportunity to bypass these recommendations. This is what we were referring to regards to enforcing the SSA. How it was worded in the first revision we felt it was not being addressed in a manner of importance and almost felt like the SSA was a secondary thought for applicants. Police and EEBC Licensing Department already do conduct joint enforcement visits to licensed premises in the Borough. This was not what we were referring to regarding enforcement of SSA.

We understand that conditions cannot be put in as mandatory local ones without a Cumulative Impact Zone Policy, this is something Police may investigate this avenue in the future. As always Licensing is a stepped approach to things and believe for the moment, Epsom will benefit from a SSA over a CIZP. Police will always be the main source for information regarding crime & disorder within EEB. This will show through any enforcement visits, application objections and general work to provide a safer neighbourhood.

Police are happy with all the amendments and additions made to the Policy since initial consultation and support the work being done by yourself and others.
