REPORT SUMMARY

The Committee is asked to note the current situation on the following issues raised previously.

1 Hack Sand Track, foot of Walton Downs – Minute 12 a) and 15 a)

1.1 No response has yet been received to the Head of Legal and Democratic Service's letter to the Horserace Betting Levy Board regarding this matter.

2 Parking on land in front of the Derby Arms public house – public consultation – Minute 14 a)

2.1 Officers are considering all the issues surrounding the car parking proposal, and will take the consultation forward in light of the outcome of further enquiries.

3 Condition of hedge - Langley Vale horse margin – Minute 14 g)

3.1 The Chairman raised the issue with Surrey County Council Highways Service, and the following response was received:

"I am aware of this location, the actual Bridle Path is a Right of Way and not actually maintained by the Local Highway Team.

That being said I know some of the history here, fence panels being installed and a hedge planted to grow through for some screening etc.

This is not considered a maintenance priority and I regret with the budgets we have been given this year this matter is considered very low priority in terms of safety and highway maintenance and it is unlikely we would be able to fund any work here this year."

4 Use of the hatched area for hack riding – Minute 15 c)

4.1 The hatched area was opened by the Training Grounds Management Board for hack riding in July.
